


Pecos / Pecos Lite Bed Assembly Instructions

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Bed Assembly (Illustration of Pecos Bed)

- Identify all pieces before beginning. Lay out parts as shown in diagram above. 2.

Note: To protect the wood only use a hammer with the wood block in shipping box as a pad, to tap down parts. Or a rubber mallet works nicely with a baggie over the mallet (no black marks). 3.

- Assemble headboard and footboard. For footboard: Use LOWER shoulder screws for crosspiece. 4.
- Attach both crosspieces to one leg then attach to the other leg.

Note: When attaching crosspieces to shoulder screws on legs; the top shoulder screw should be located in the center of the crosspiece. Refer to our "CAUTION SHEET. 5.

- Install 4-5/8" shoulder screws into predrilled holes on headboard and footboard crosspieces. 6.
- Attach headboard to footboard using the two side rails with ledger inside.
- Attach the center support rail (it will be tight). 7.
- Tap down rails and center support until snug. 7.

Note: It is important that all joints are tapped down completely.

- Install 4-5/16" x 1" wood pins in holes in side rail ledgers. 8.
- Lay out slat roll, strap up, so that end slats overlap wood pins.

Important: Screw center slat tight to side rail ledge using 2-1" screws. Make sure the slat is tight against the side rail. Failure to screw down center slat may cause damage to the bed.
